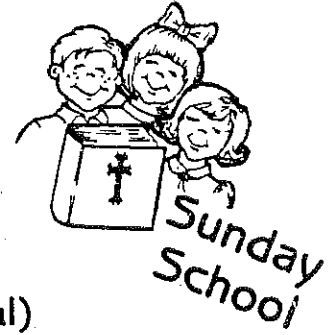


KINGDOM KIDS - SUNDAY SCHOOL
