


From the Pastor's Desk . . .





Walk-A-Thon donations are due on or before Thursday, April 25 for the annual Rail Trail Cleanup and Walk-A-Thon




It's that time to once again work with the Bay Area Community Foundation for the annual Rail Trail Cleanup Community Service Project.

I am thrilled to introduce this year's VBS program to each of you as April is the month that work begins bringing this children's ministry. I am pleased to share with you that all of our station leaders are set in place and ready to set sail with your children. April ushers in the month of preparedness and with that in mind I am putting our preliminary needs we are looking for.

Staff Needed

- Preschool Aids
- Kitchen Help
- Craft Aides
- Dreamscape Builders Set Up and Tear Down Team
- Community Ice Cream "Under the Sea" Party Scoopers
- Crew Leaders

Items Needed

- Kayak or Canoe
- Fish netting
- Snorkel gear
- Scuba gear
- Large blue tarps
- Bight pool noodles (we will need to cut these) I need around 20
- 3 HUGE boxes (think refrigerator size)



Items to pick up now

- 4 oz. water bottles (I will need 150 per day x 4 days)
- Bottles of bubbles (single size bottles—they typically come in a 4 or 6 pack)
- Brown paper bags (I will need 180 per day x 4 days)
- 20 boxes of regular graham crackers (Kraft)
- Zip Lock bags (lunch and snack size)
- Goldfish crackers (6 large boxes at Gordon Food Service)
