From the Pastor's Desk . . .

Her children rise up and call her blessed; her husband also, and he praises her: "Many women have done excellently, but you surpass them all." Charm is deceitful, and beauty is vain, but a woman who fears the Lord is to be praised.

-Proverbs 31:28-30

This month we celebrate Mother's Day. (Sunday, May 12th) This isn't a religious holiday but one that I think Christians should participate in wholeheartedly. In the scriptures we see the value given to women by God. Certainly a value co-equal with men, where even in creation woman was the only creature seen fit for companionship with man. As husband and wife Adam and Eve were given authority over all the rest of creation for its care and flourishing. They were also commanded to be fruitful and multiply, with children who would join in the daily worship of God by caring for others.

After the fall, God's promise of salvation would come through a woman. Mary was blessed to carry in her womb God incarnate. In the Book of Judges we see Deborah acting as a judge for God's people, a critical role in the community. Jesus himself had disciples who were women, and we know from the Gospels some of them were the first to see the empty tomb and the resurrected Lord. Dorcas was a matriarch in the early church who showed care for those in need. Lydia was a patron who used her lucrative business to fund the ministries of the early church. Mother or not, all women are precious in God's eyes and we as Christains should share that vision.

Yet on Mother's Day I want to recognize the women who have been blessed to be called mom. Luther considers motherhood to be the highest calling of a woman, just as fatherhood is the highest calling of a man. Being a mom is hard work too. If you read all of Proverbs 31, you hear of a woman who is industrious, kind, compassionate, and most importantly of all "fears the Lord." In all that she does she is selfless for her God and, in proper order, her family and community as well. To quote Jane Austen's Elizabeth in Pride and Prejudice "she would certainly be a fearsome thing to behold." And that is exactly what Solomon is saying in Proverbs 31. Faithful Christian mothers ought to have their children rise up and call her blessed. Husbands should praise their wives for their motherhood. You moms are a blessing. Your calling in life as mom is not easy. Your reliance on God is an example of God's provision for us.


